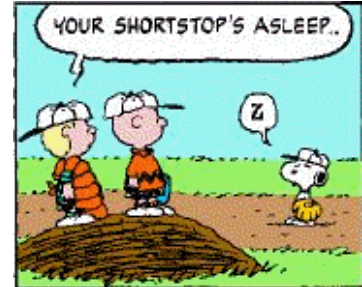

The Saints are also perfect at home, going 5-0. *D-C* has won all of their non section games, losing only to *Winsted* in the Section and *Delano* in the division. *Maple Lake* sits in the middle of the standings, losing to the two teams ahead of them in the standings and beating the only two teams below them in the standings. *Delano* seems to win if the bats get going and they score more than five runs, the problem being that's only happened twice in their seven section games. *Hutchinson* has been the biggest surprise, losing their first six section games before recovering to defeat *Delano* and *Plato*.

Howard Lake relies on a deep pitching staff to win most of their games because the opponent usually doesn't score more than 3 runs (except *Monticello*). *Monticello* has climbed into a virtual tie for the lead by defeating the *Lakers* in back to back games, scoring 7 and 8 runs. *Buffalo* has exploded for more than 10 runs in four of their five wins, but when they score less than ten, the *Bulldogs* are 1 and 4, keeping them close to the .500 mark. *Rockford* has only scored more than 6 runs once and tends to give up more than that most of the time. *Cokato* was not able to score more than four runs while they lost their first seven games, but scored 6 runs then 8 runs in their two wins.
